


Pilot Teachers - Student Profile Page

When on this page, it is useful to quickly scan the Main Course Actions section and see green or red bars."







Teachers - Early Course Actions

"I **loved** using clarity today! I used the hasn't completed the AHC indicator. I was able to click on a student's phone number and contact students who had not turned in the AHC. I reminded them that I need the contract by the end of the week and that the start here folder needs to be completed as well. I heard back from a couple of students which was great. **It was so slick and easy!**"

"As my late Spring class started this week, it's been really helpful to have the information all complied **in one space**. I've been keeping an eye on the Early Actions tab through this week, to kind of get a quick look at where all students are."

"Yesterday I sat down and keeping the "Student Profile" tab open in one screen and Google Voice in another, I reached out to each student's parent via text introducing myself and giving a quick update on their students progress in the course. I got a lot of **great communication** from parents (which I NEVER get from the welcome email alone) and it was nice to be able to reach out to some and make that "first" contact with some good news. For those students who are already struggling, it helped to **get a few moving**. I can see this because whereas yesterday in the "Early Actions" tab there was red all over the place, now it's much more cleaned up and consolidated (there is less red in the "no activity" section and the "no AHC" tab. Which on a quick glance tells me that not only were the texts yesterday overall helpful, that quite a few students who had been falling a little behind are **back in and working**. It's great to see that data all in one spot so on a quick glance I know what's going on. If I still see some students struggling come Monday I'll definitely use that information to reach out to site coordinators. I'll be paying particular attention to the "new student" indicator as well as the "no activity" indicator."

"...having all of the information in in one place **saves me so much time**. One screen with so many less clicks is wonderful. I emailed a student several days ago that I hadn't seen him being active and he immediately did three assignments."
